Pillowcase Instructions

Finished size: Standard Pillowcase

Materials:

34" yard fabric for pillow body
14" yard fabric for pillow cuff

2" strip for accent

Directions:

- 1. Stack all fabrics on top of each other with folds and selvages lining up
- 2. Trim selvage edges so all fabrics are equal width
- 3. Take accent piece and press in half lengthwise wrong sides together
- 4. Open pillow body fabric to a single layer right side up.
- 5. Place the accent piece on top of the right side of pillow body material, matching raw edges.
- 6. Add cuff piece right side down to the accent/pillow body, matching raw edges
- 7. Sew or serge ¼"
- 8. Open cuff out and press seam out toward cuff raw edge
- 9. Fold pillow right sides together lengthwise
- 10. Starting with the cuff edge, sew or serge the length of the pillow body and across the bottom (opposite end of cuff)
- 11. Serge or turn under the raw cuff edge and fold to the inside of the pillow covering the accent seam
- 12. On outside of cuff, top stitch in place 1/8" from accent seam

Option: You could use a double needle for a decorative touch or sew under the accent fold to hide your stitch
